He said that Atmanirbharta can be a success story by adopting needonomics which is ethical, nonviolent and spiritual in nature. There is need for sharing the responsibility calling for pricing policy of public utilities to be linked with inflation. He explained that Economy can be made consumer friendly by adopting NAW Worth) (Need, Affordability and approach of international marketing with focus on the need-based priorities in choices of all kinds. This was followed by the three rounds of questions for the teams on the following themes - Economics, Business World and Current affairs. It was an exciting series of questions which challenged the students and brought out the best in them. The first place in the competition was bagged by ITL Public School, Dwarka. Second and third position was secured by N K Bagrodia Global School, Dwarka and Mother's Mary School, Mayur Vihar respectively.
