

The date was chosen to honor the United Nations General Assembly's adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) on 10th December 1948, the first global statement of International Human Rights and Principles. The theme of Human Rights Day 2021 was "Reducing Inequalities and Advancing Human Rights". This year's theme was related to 'Equality' and Article of UDHR which says, "All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights." The principles of equality and non-discrimination are at the heart of human rights. 


CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION-25 DEC,2021






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ZONAL SPORTS ACTIVITIES
