




SURAKSHA COMMITTEE - 2022-23

he primary responsibility of the Suraksha Committee is to safeguard individual children and address concerns regarding their emotional and physical well-being. In order to ensure this Suraksha Committee in our school has laid down briefs on fire safety management, structural safety, how to deal with violence and ragging, and how to ensure the safety of children in school buses, among others.

The Suraksha committee is working under the supervision of the Head of the school. Regular meetings are conducted under the same. One such meeting was organised on 23rd July 2022. The meeting was held in hybrid mode to accommodate the parents who could not attend the meeting physically.

HOS Ms Anjali Kharbanda along with the members of the committee shared a few changes we have introduced for the further safety of our children. The teachers are now accompanied by lady Martials in the buses so that discipline could be maintained.

The timings for the recess are now divided for the students in order to avoid crowding.

Along with providing quality education, the Suraksha committee believes ensuring a safe environment should be one of the top priorities for schools. Schools must recognize the power of vigilance as the key to protecting children.











INCLUSION AND INCLUSIVE STRATEGIES

he workshop on Inclusive Education was taken by Pre-Primary Academic Coordinator Ms Satinder Kaur for the teachers of the Junior wing and Primary wing. The workshop started with calming breathing exercises followed by tips and techniques to be implemented in classrooms for Inclusive Education. Some of the tips shared during the workshop are as follows:

- Teach Special children-various skills, to be independent, to respect others etc.
- "A to Z of Inclusion for teachers" was explained with relevant examples to educate teachers on the importance and ways of inclusion.
- Parents, teachers, peers and the community should work together for the special needs children by removing all the attitudinal and environmental barriers.
- Every child is unique and should be given unconditional acceptance without making them mascots.
- The difference between Exclusion, segregation, integration and inclusion was explained.
- A special educator and counsellor should always be involved.
- To make teaching and learning accessible to all. Teachers should use a variety of learning styles.
- Signage of Directions should be used.
- Buddy system to be followed.
- Documentation for each special needs child is essential.
- Teachers were asked to read in detail about one disability and share it with co-teachers.

In order to emphasize the need to include Special needs children in the classroom, a video was shown to the teachers. The workshop ended with important points to be implemented in classes for better and effective learning of special needs children.
